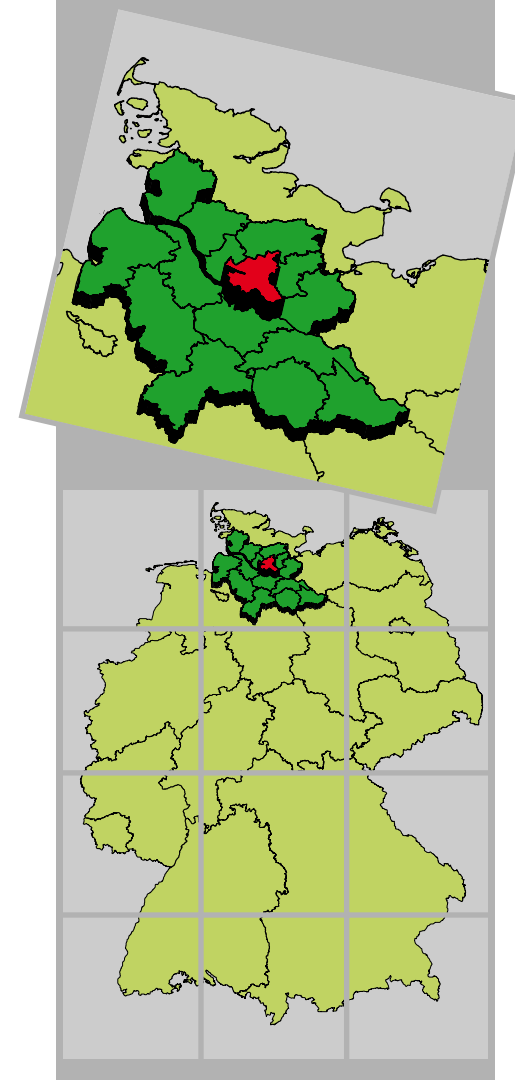

HAMBURG METROPOLITAN AREA

The Hamburg metropolitan area includes Hamburg and 14 other rural districts. These are north of the river Elbe the rural districts Duchy of Lauenburg, Pinneberg, Segeberg, Steinburg, Stormarn and Dithmarschen and in the south the Lower-Saxony rural districts Cuxhaven, Harburg, Lüchow-Dannenberg, Lüneburg, Rotenburg (Wümme), Soltau-Fallingb., Stade and Uelzen. The Hamburg metropolitan area spans 19 802 square kilometers, where roughly 4.3 million people live.

The closer area comprises the city itself and the six directly bounding rural districts. These are Pinneberg, Segeberg, Stormarn and Duchy of Lauenburg in Schleswig-Holstein and Harburg und Stade in Lower-Saxony. This area spans 7304 square kilometers and has 3.1 million inhabitants.

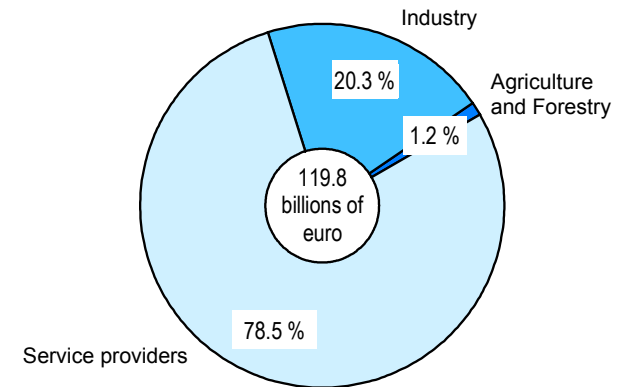
