



### Duration of Residence in Germany

65 % of all British nationals resident in Hamburg have been living in Germany for at least eight years.

### Change of Residence

592 people from Great Britain took up residence in Hamburg, whilst 848 people moved from Hamburg to Great Britain.

### Marriages

19 British men married German women, nine German men married British women.

### Education

During the school year 2006/2007, 162 British pupils attended general schools of education, 29 British nationals attended vocational schools in Hamburg. During the winter term 2006/2007, 64 students from Great Britain enrolled in Hamburg colleges, 49 of those at the University of Hamburg and seven at the University of Applied Sciences.

## Employment

1,324 British nationals were employed at Hamburg-based companies, paying into social security, i. e. 43.1 percent of the total number of British nationals aged between 18 and 60 years living in Hamburg.


